

# Providing Public Testimony

A guide to providing testimony at Dane County public meetings



Registration for meetings can be completed online or in person. In order to register online to speak, the registration needs to be completed 30 minutes in advance of the meeting. The link to register can be found on the agenda for each meeting.



Registrants are given **five** minutes to testify before any board, commission, or committee, including the Board of Supervisors. In some circumstances public comment may be limited to three minutes.



Members of the public can speak to most items on agendas except items under the following headings:

- Special Matters and Announcements
- Minutes
- Motions from Previous Meetings
- Special Order of Business
- Such Other Business



To request an interpreter for a public meeting, contact the phone number that is listed on the bottom of the agenda under “NOTE: If you need an interpreter, translator, etc.” This request should be done at least three business days prior to the meeting.
